### **Meeting Minutes**

#### **Welcome and Introductions**

Jerri Bone welcomed members. She reminded the committee that a recording of the meeting would be posted on the DISD website.

#### **School Safety Grant –Paul Neumann**

The School Safety Grant for \$278,000 is nearly completed. The funds used for a radio repeater system needs to be tested and signed off on prior to payment. The system allows each campus to talk to one another in an emergency.

Cycle 1 –School Safety Grant will provide funding for window safety film, fencing, grid mapping for each campus, door numbering, and the completion of the minimum components required by House Bill 3. Until construction completion on the three remodeled campuses, no safety upgrades can be added.

Cycle 2 – School Safety Grant will be used for police salaries and equipment. This fall we should have an armed officer at every campus. By next year, all officers should be TCOL certified. Officers are assigned to one campus throughout the school year. The goal is for officers to build relationships with students. The district has to replace Officer Riddick at SMS and Officer Hunt at BMc. They are employed by the Denison Police Department.

Civilian Response to Active Shooter Event (CRASE) will be presented to all staff the week of in-service. Advanced Law Enforcement Rapid Respond Training (ALERT) active shooter training will be held at DHS next Tuesday. All agencies in the county will participate.

Mr. Newmann was extremely complementary of the relationship and assistance provided by the City of Denison police department. He stated they have given Denison ISD an abundance of equipment.

A recommendation was made to add more information to the district website so the community becomes aware of the safety procedures and implementations added to each campus.

## **Mental Health – Jacquine Melancon**

### **May is Mental Health Month**

- A proclamation will be read at the Board meeting supporting Mental Health month and supported by the Texoma Behavioral Health Leadership Team, chair, Dr. Jeremy McMillan. Jackie Melancon will present information on how we are supporting students' and teachers' mental health.
- We have supported our teachers with educational emails on ways to support your mental health. We have supported our community with tips and coping strategies on district Facebook page.

### **Advising Genz Grant**

DAEP is piloting Advising Genz, which is a discipline-reimagined program. This program allows students to watch videos and take quizzes on topics related to their behavior infraction, which provides a replacement behavior for different topics such as fighting, bullying, negative social media behavior and drugs and alcohol. Currently, 47 students have enrolled in the program since March 5, 2024.

We have applied for a grant to remain in the program for next year. We will find out May 28 if this will continue for next year.

### **Summer PD**

In campus improvement meeting – there was a lot of feedback concern student's behavior. This summer PD will focus on supporting teachers and campuses on behavior management.

Training will include- 4 hours of TBRI Trust Based Relational Intervention and Trauma- Informed Classroom training. This training will be provided by Grayson County Department of Juvenile Services. They will also provide support to campuses. 2 hours of PBIS Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports overview will be provided by Amanda Gunter and Jackie Melancon.

Each campus has selected at campus team to revive PBIS on their campuses. Campus teams and new teachers to the district will also participate in a Positive Behavior Principals training on July 30 and August 30. Training about 300 teachers.

The district has shifted from CPI, Crisis Prevention Institute, to ***Handle with Care***, which is a certificate program for managing verbal de-escalation and restraint. Each campus will have a trained team. All campuses will get 2 hours of verbal de-escalation training during PD week at the start of school.

**Other:**

Good feedback was given for the Fentanyl training provided to Scott Middle School and Denison High School. The opinion was that the students were very attentive during the presentation. The middle school students asked multiple questions. A different curriculum will be examined for next year's training.
